Do you need assistance with making minor repairs to your home?

INHS provides free* home repair work to homeowners in the City of Ithaca & Tompkins County who are disabled, aged 60 and older, and in some cases, single heads of household with dependents of any age. Health and safety repairs are a top priority.

Labor is free, and in most cases, materials are provided as well.

Repairs include, but are not limited to:

- Fixing or replacing deteriorated steps
- Improving lighting
- Alleviating trip hazards
- Adding handrails and grab bars
- Fixing leaky faucets
- Replacing broken windows
